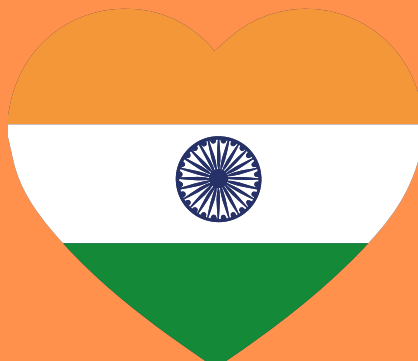

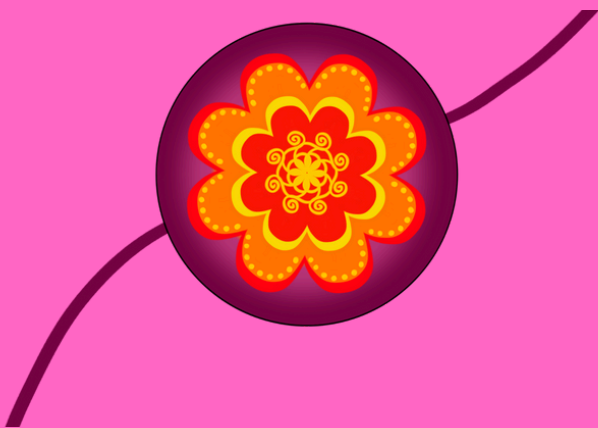

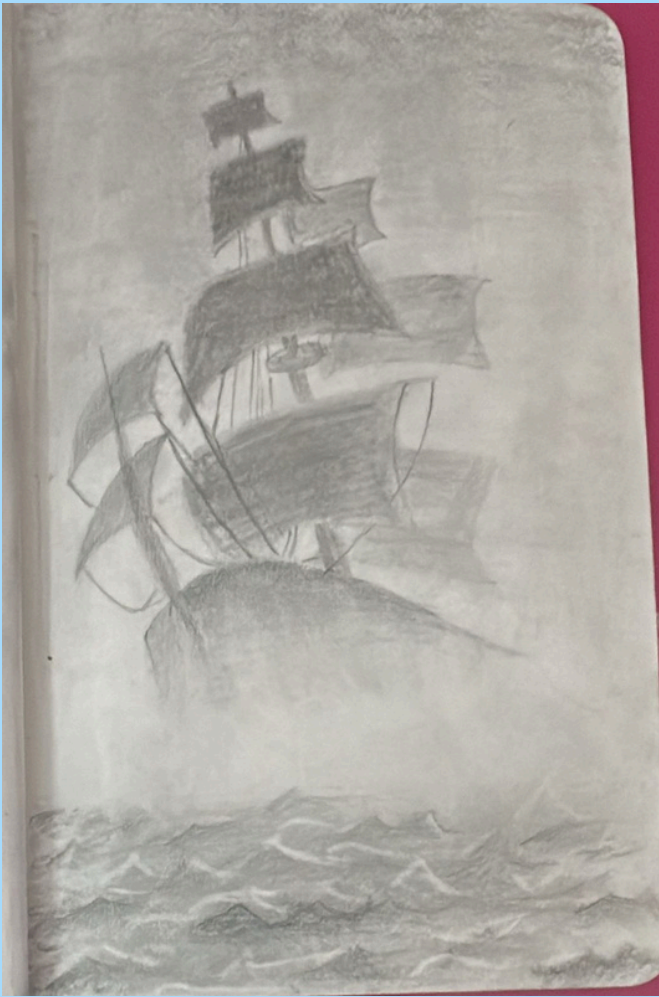


FEAR IN THE AIR
