What was the RECENT INDO-PAK CONFLICT

The FIRST SPARK:

ON 22ND April, some terrorists attacked tourists in Pahalgam in Kashmir, a famous tourist spot. 25 Indian and 1 Nepali citizen was killed. Many famous celebrities also showed their grief for the attack

Diplomatic actions:

India suspended the Indus Water Treaty between India and Pakistan. The Atari check post at Wagah Border was closed and the Pakistani nationals were given a deadline to return to Pakistan. Pakistani web series, movies and songs were banned by the Indian government.

While Pakistan closed it's airspace for Indian planes.

Operation Sindoor:

ON May 7, India attacked only terrorists sites in Pakistan, avenging the Pahalgam attack.

Pakistan attacked Indian airbases in Udhampur, Pathankot and Srinagar using drones. India was able to neutralise the attack successful using it air defence system.

Pakistan was also continuously shelling in the outskirts of Jammu & Kashmir, including a gurudwara in Poonch. India gave a befitting reply and attacked the air defence system in Lahore.

This cycle of attacks repeated a few more times.

Then, a ceasefire, which was called "only an understanding" by our foreign secretary Vikram Misri, was concluded after a talk between the DGMOs (Director General of Military Operations) of both the sides on 10 May

Ahmedabad Plane Crash:

Air India's flight AI - 171 took off from Ahmedabad International Airport on 12th June for London, also carrying former Gujarat chief minister, Mr. Vijay Rupani. After around 1 minute after the take off, the plane, carrying 256 passengers, crashed into the mess (canteen) of a government medical college. Police, ambulance, and fire brigade reached the spot immediately. The investigation agencies reached soon after. While the news channels were also doing live coverage of the tragic incident.

Israel-Iran War:

Israel launched a drone attack on Iran's nuclear sites, killing some important people. Israel said that Iran's developing nuclear program was not for peaceful reasons, but was a threat on the state sovereignty of Israel. Then Iran retaliated. While Israel claims that it coordinated with the USA before the strikes.

Indriyani River Bridge Breaks:

In the late afternoon of 16 June, because of overcrowding and people taking 2-wheelers on the foot bridge, the bridge on the Indriyani river in Pune collapsed, taking lives of 4 people and injuring 51 people. The search operations were carried by 2 forces of NDRF (National Disaster Response Force).

Kedarnath Helicopter Crash:

A helicopter belonging to Aryan Aviation was crashed in Rudraprayag District in Kedarnath. Seven people (the total people on board), including ten pilot, died in the tragic incident.

RCB STAMPEDE:

AFTER RCB'S ICONIC WIN, THEY DECIDED TO CELEBRATE IT ON THEIR HOME GROUND, CHINNASWAMY CRICKET STADIUM, IN BENGALURU. BUT 10-TIMES OF THE CAPACITY OF THE STADIUM ARRIVED, PUSHING BACK THE SECURITY AND THE ORGANISERS. THE DEATH TOLL LIFTED TILL 11, AND AROUND 70 WERE INJURED. THE CASE IS GOING ON IN THE KARNATAKA HIGH COURT.

LA Protests:

Protests sparked in Los Angeles when allegedly American President Donald Trump deployed National Guards in Los Angeles for immigration reasons. But then protesters attacked the riot controllers. They were controlled by leaving tear gas. Many of them were arrested. Those who escaped blocked traffic on a highway.

Russia-Ukraine War Continues:

Amidst the world praying for peace, the conflict gets in its 3rd year. In April, Russia declared an Easter truce (ceasefire) for the celebration of Easter. But, both the sides accused each other of breaching the ceasefire. According to Ukrainian President Zelenskyy, air raid alarms rang multiple times.

LA Wildfires:

Wildfires broke in Los Angeles, California, USA. The firefighters arrived on the spot immediately. (For more information, please see the last page of the January Edition.)
