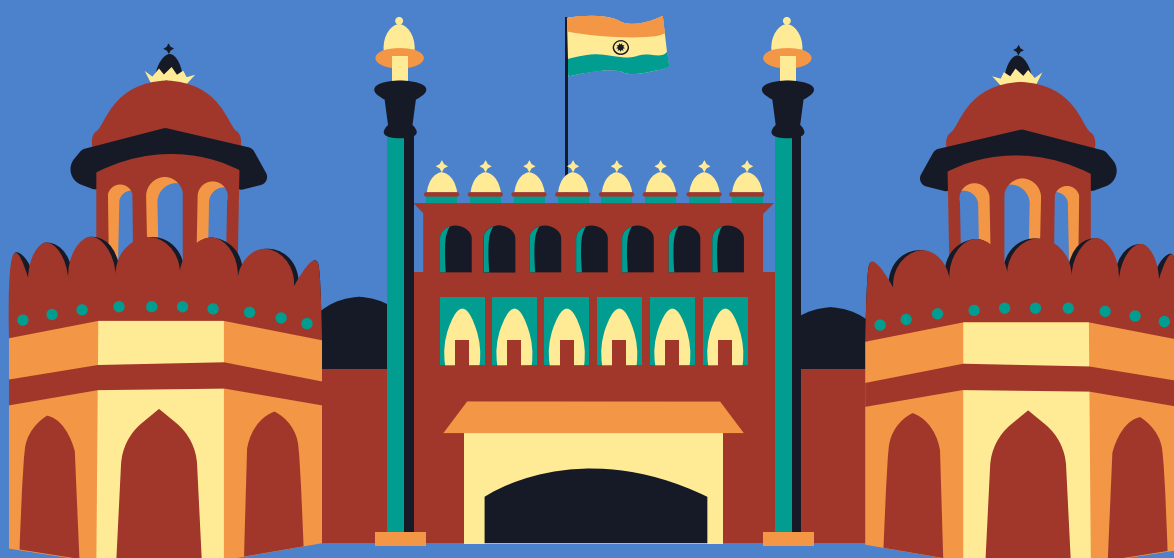
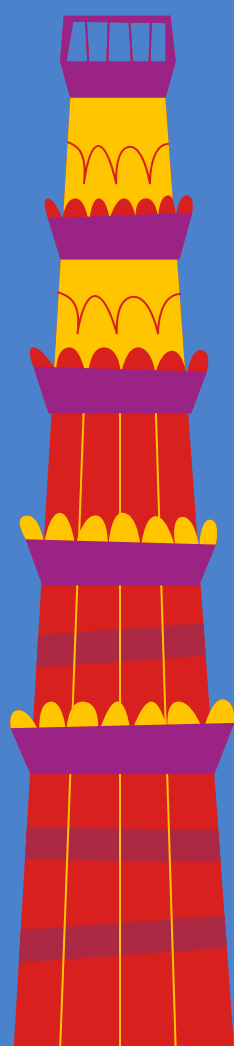

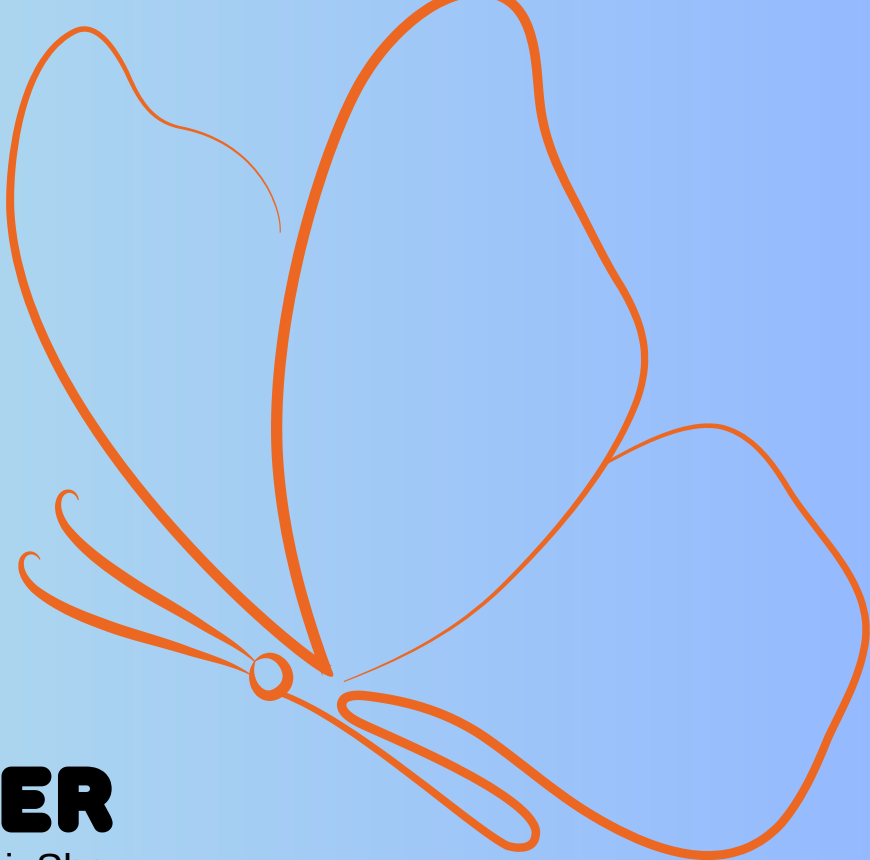
Dr. Bhimrao Ramji Ambedkar

Dr. Bhimrao Ramji Ambedkar, better known as Dr. BR Ambedkar was born on 14 April 1891. He was a Indian jurist, economist, social reformer and the first Law and Justice Minister of Independent India. He was graduated from Elphinstone College, affiliated with the University of Bombay, then he studied economics at Columbia University, London. He was also trained in Law at Gray's Inn. He published many journals and advocated equal rights for Dalits, who were considered as untouchables at that time, they were not allowed to drink water from public wells, some other person has to pour water for them from a certain height. One time, Ambedkar and his elder brother were going to meet their father by train. They got off at a small station in Maharashtra called Masur. They hired a hand pulled rickshaw to get to their father's house, but when the rickshaw driver came to know that they are Dalits, he pushed them off the rickshaw. Then they had to walk to their father's house. It was summer season, so he felt thirsty, but they were not allowed to drink from the well. But after some time he felt so thirsty that he forgot about everything and drank water. Then he was beaten up by the public. This affected him deeply. He was the chairman of the committee that drafted our Indian constitution. He was came to be known as Babasaheb fondly. He was announced as the law minister of our country officially on 15 August 1947. He was conferred with the Bharat Ratna posthumously in 1990.
