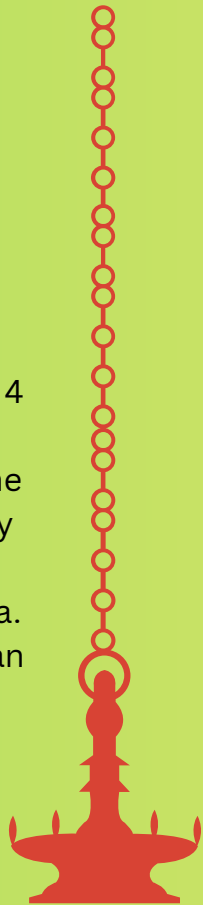
India closes at no. 1 in the international Astronomy Olympiad

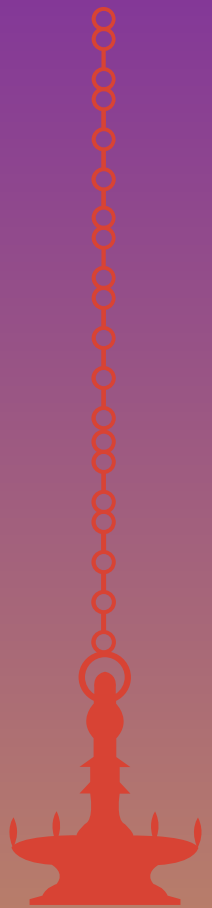
Pitthu to be added as an official sport in MP

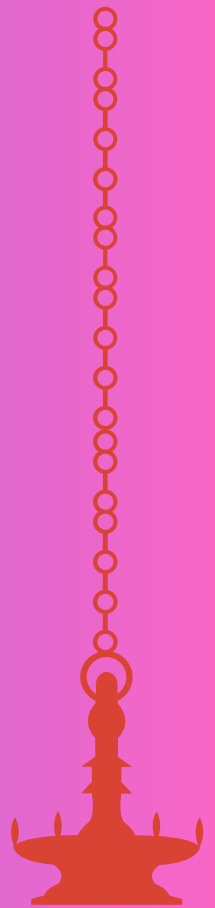

THE PRESS CONFERENCE

In the post match press conference, the Indian skipper Surya Kumar Yadav (nicknamed SKY) was asked about the India Pakistan rivalry, where he cleared India's intent on the topic by saying 'What rivalry are you talking about? When me and my team step on the ground, the only thing I tell my team is "there is a lot of audience in the stands, we have the responsibility to entertain them; so, let's play some good cricket." Then, when he was asked that 'Was this the best game you have ever played?' He carefully diverted the topic to his debut match, saying that 'My best game was my debut match, when I stepped in in the Indian jersey for the first time, and I always thank the god for the same by closing my eyes during the national anthem.' Surya didn't use Pakistan's name even once in the press conference. This was, in my opinion, one of the best post match conferences in the history of Indian cricket.

Other Controversies

In the Super Four match, Haris Rauf, a Pakistani pacer, got an Indian batsman out and showed a plane crash with his hand, resembling Pakistan's claim that they shot Indian jets down during the May - June conflict (picture no. 1). Jasprit Bumrah did the same when he got Haris Rauf's wicket in the finals (picture no. 2).

Pakistani batter Farhan celebrated his fifty by acting to fire gunshots on India from his bat (picture no. 3).

MOHSIN NAQVI TROPHY SCANDAL

Mohsin Naqvi is ACC (Asian Cricket Council) Chairman and Pakistan's interior minister was going to hand over the trophy to India after India defeated Pakistan in the finals. But, BCCI refused to accept the trophy from Mohsin Naqvi because he is also the interior minister of Pakistan.

"We can't accept a trophy from a minister of a hostile country," said BCCI. Abhishek Sharma received the Player Of The Tournament and Tilak Verma received the Man Of The Match from the hosts (UAE), but skipper Suryakumar Yadav didn't collect the trophy and medals from ACC chairperson Mohsin Naqvi. And, the Indian team didn't shake hands with Mohsin Naqvi on the stage. In the trophy ceremony, Indian celebrated by lifting an imaginary trophy and dancing (picture no. 6). Mohsin Naqvi reportedly took the trophy and the medals to his hotel room. "If we don't collect the trophy and medals, it doesn't mean someone will run away with it," commented BCCI. "Whom else do you think shall give them the trophy?" Commented Mohsin Naqvi. Then he submitted the trophy and medals to the ACC office in Dubai and asked India to collect them from there, while BCCI refused and asked to drop the trophy directly to BCCI office.
