There are four *Navaratri*s in the whole year, they are:

Magha Gupt Navratri

Chaitra Navratri

Ashadha Gupt Navratri

Sharada Navratri

There is *Chaitra Navratri* in April (*Garba* is mostly performed in *Sharada Navratri*).

In the *Navratri*, we worship the following forms of goddess':

First day - *Pratipada* (*Shailputri* puja)

Second day - *Dwitiya* (*Brahmcharini* puja)

Third day - *Tritiya* (*Chandraghanta* puja)

Fourth day - *Chaturthi* (*Kushmanda* puja)

Fifth day - *Panchami* (*Skandamata* puja)

Sixth day - *Shasthi* (*Katyayani* puja)

Seventh day - *Saptami* (*Kalaratri* puja)

Eighth day - *Ashthami* (*Mahagauri* puja)

Ninth day - *Navmi* (*Siddhidatri* puja)

On the first day, there is *Ghatasthapna* (placing a *ghat* (a type of bowl) to start the *Navratri* puja). On eighth day, there is *Kanya puja* (feeding nine girls and two boys imagining the girls as *Goddess Durga* and the boys to be *Hanuman* and *Bhairavji*). In this *Navratri*, on the last day (*Navmi*), there is *Ram Navmi* (birthday of Lord Rama).

The mission was originally planned for only eight days, but because of malfunctions, they were not able to return to Earth in time.
